## **JUDGING REQUIREMENTS**

### **A1 LIST BREED SPECIALIST**

For persons who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the breed and have completed their first appointment. These persons will have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK.

### **A1LIST NON SPECIALIST**

For persons who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the breed and have completed their first appointment. These persons will have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK.

### **A2 LIST BREED SPECIALIST**

For persons who fulfil all the requirements of the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK.

### **A2 LIST NON SPECIALIST**

For persons who fulfil all the requirements of the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK.

### **A3 LIST BREED SPECIALIST**

To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed. To have judged a minimum of 60 dogs over a wide geographical area. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. To have attended a Conformation & Movement “Hands-on-Assessment” conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. To have attended and passed at least one Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK. To have stewarded at 12 shows. Kennel Club mandatory requirement for a judge awarding CC's for the first time to have attended a K.C. Field Trial at Open Stake Level or an Open Gundog Working Test for Retrievers.

### **A3 LIST NON SPECIALIST**

To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed). To have judged a minimum of 60 dogs over a wide geographical area and to have awarded CC's in at least one other Gundog breed. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. To have attended a Conformation & Movement “Hands-on-Assessment” conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. To have attended and passed at least one Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK. To have stewarded at 12 shows. Kennel Club mandatory requirement for a judge awarding CC's for the first time to have attended a K.C. Field Trial at Open Stake Level or an Open Gundog Working Test for Retrievers.

### **B LIST BREED SPECIALIST**

To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience, owning and / or exhibiting the breed. To have judged 40 dogs over a wide geographical area. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. To have attended a Conformation & Movement “Hands-on-Assessment” conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. To have attended and passed a Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK. To have stewarded at 12 shows.

### **B LIST NON SPECIALIST**

To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience in any Gundog breed. To have judged 40 dogs over a wide geographical area. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. To have attended a Conformation & Movement “Hands-on-Assessment” conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. To have attended and passed a Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and have the support of the NSDTR Club of UK. To have stewarded at 12 shows.
